123443 Allotment Gardens, High Street, Scotter – a planning application for change of use of land currently used as temporary allotments to cemetery land.

Comment of support. The Clerk is to submit the following comment : "My Council strongly supports this application, in its capacity as burial authority for the parish of Scotter. Whilst it accepts that there is a technical requirement for a change of use application, it would wish to remind the planning authority that the whole of the land, whether currently used as burial grounds or as temporary allotments, was initially purchased for specific use as a cemetery. The area currently used as burial grounds is

approaching capacity and the approval of this application is a necessary step in ensuring the provision of this essential local service into the future."
