24 2016/17 To agree the Parish Councils response to the Proposed Submission Central Lincs Plan.

RESOLVED : to agree the Parish Council response as follows -

Scotter Parish Council broadly supports the Central Lincolnshire Plan. We share the social, environmental and economic aspirations and objectives of the Plan. We are of the opinion that the forecasts of housing needs are too high given the state of the Steel industry which supports a large part of the economy of the northern half of the area and the slow progress and uncertainty of the embryonic wind energy development park on the South Bank of the Humber.

In terms of the plans specifically for our community we feel that we have to accept them given the National need for more housing. Our infrastructure is creaking under the strain of previous development which was not accompanied by any improvement to said infrastructure and there must be significant improvements to accommodate further housing. Whilst we would have preferred small scale sites we recognise the difficulties this would have presented.
